Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Sutter Butte Flood Control Agency (SBFCA), Yuba City, California, will receive sealed Bids as follows:

- ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COST:** \$600,000 - \$650,000
- CONTRACTOR'S CALIFORNIA LICENSE AND/OR CLASS REQUIRED:** Either a C13-Fencing Contractor License or a General Engineering Contractor A License (A License).
- PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Work performed under this Contract includes the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, tools, incidentals, and supervision for:  
  
Vegetation removal, tree trimming, fence removal and disposal, chain link fence and gates fabrication and installation; miscellaneous removals and disposal as shown on the plans. All work must be completed by November 15, 2022.
- NON-MANDATORY PRE BID JOB WALK:** July 27, 2022 @ 1:00 p.m. LOCATION: 243 Second Street, Yuba City, CA (Levee District 1 Corporation Yard)

Award of this Contract requires the Bidder to have a valid California Contractor's License with the classifications identified above. Award of this Contract also requires the Bidder to demonstrate its qualifications to perform the required work.

Each Bid must be submitted on the bid forms provided in the Contract Documents.

This is a construction project in accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code. This Contract is subject to: (1) Federal Labor Standards Provisions as required by the Davis-Bacon Act and other applicable Federal requirements, (2) Equal Employment Opportunity requirements pursuant to Executive Order 11246, and (3) Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) development pursuant to Executive Order 12432.

All labor on the Project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates as established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor or as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR). The higher of the two rates will be paid in accordance with the following acts and codes:

- (1) The Davis-Bacon Act, and
- (2) Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code.

Copies of the prevailing rate of per diem wages, as determined by the Director of the DIR, are on file at the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors:

All substantive and/or technical questions shall be submitted in writing and will be responded to in writing via Addendum issued to all Contract Document holders. The deadline for submitting questions will be 5:00 p.m. on August 3, 2022.

**ACCEPTANCE OF BID; TIME OF AWARD; EXECUTION OF CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS**

Award, if made, will be to the responsive, responsible Bidder with the lowest Bid amount. SBFCA's Board of Directors reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, to waive any informality in any Bid, and to determine which Bid, in the judgment of the Board, is the lowest responsive Bid of a responsible Bidder.

Although it is anticipated that the Contract award, if made, and the Notice to Proceed will be made within Thirty (30) Calendar Days of Bid Opening, Bids and Bid Guarantees must be held as binding for Sixty (60) Calendar Days from Bid opening.

If the lowest responsive, responsible bidder fails or refuses to execute the Contract for the Project, SBFCA may, in its discretion, award the Contract for the Project to the second lowest, responsive responsible bidder. If the second lowest, responsive, responsible bidder fails or refuses to execute the Contract for the Project, SBFCA may, in its discretion, award the Contract for the Project to the third lowest, responsive, responsible bidder. Any Bidder to whom a Contract for the Project is awarded who fails to execute the Contract and file acceptable bonds and insurance certificates as required in the Contract Documents will have its Bid Guarantee forfeited.
