CALL TO ORDER

Chair Jon Munger called the meeting to order. The roll of the committee and attendance was called and is reflected above.

ACTION ITEM

Approval of March 6, 2017 Meeting Minutes:

SBFCA STAFF REPORTS

Director of Engineering Michael Bessette provided an overview of SBFCA's March 12, 2017, Board meeting. Agenda items include a staff recommendation that the Board extend its emergency declaration given the uncertainty with Oroville releases, potential storm events and spring runoff. The Board will also review a proposed amendment to the three-year budget and vote on a date for a public budget hearing (likely May).

Mr. Bessette also gave a summary of ongoing construction projects. Active construction on Completion Projects (aka "Gap Projects"), will continue through July. The works includes the installation of a seepage berm at the Yuba City Raw Water Intake and relief wells at the Union Pacific Railroad crossing and just

north of Star Bend. Other work will include the demolition of Sutter County's storage shed and replacement gates for work completed within LD1's jurisdiction.

Public Outreach Manager Kim Floyd shared May 17 as the date for SBFCA's annual community meeting. Meeting topics will include the performance of levees that have been repaired, a look at 2017-18 work, and future projects needed to reduce flood risk in the southern portion of the basin. Information about the meeting will be shared primarily through local media and social media.
