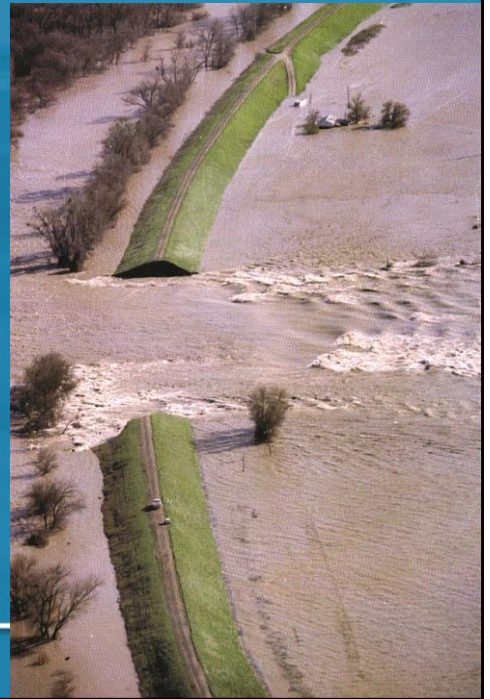

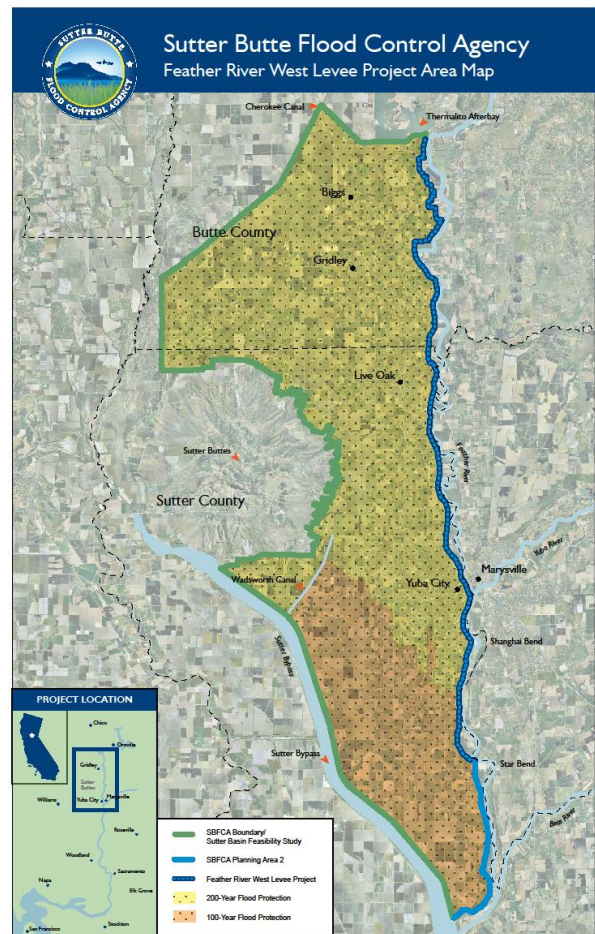

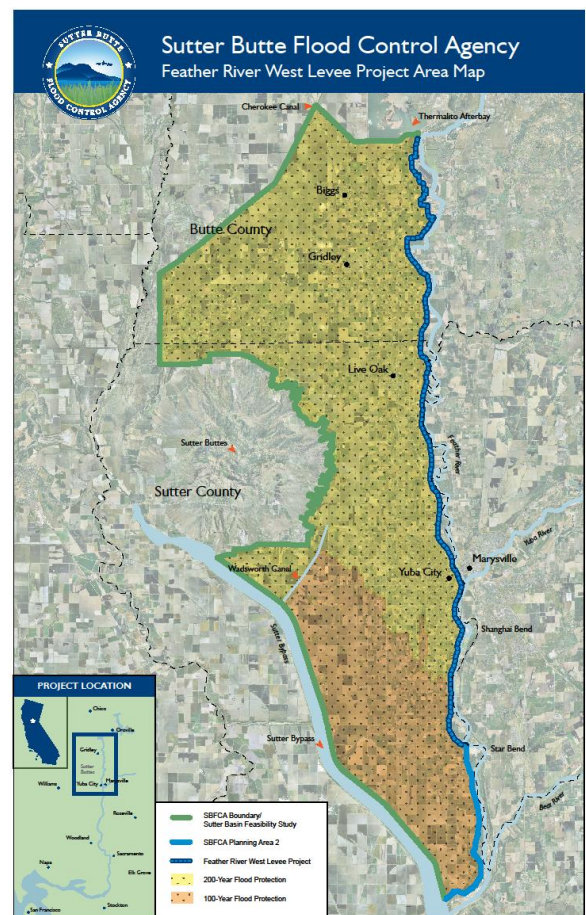
About SBFCA

- Created in September 2007
- Regional approach to finance and construct flood protection improvements
- A Joint Powers Agency (JPA) of County Of Butte, County of Sutter, Cities of Live Oak, Gridley, Biggs and Yuba City, Levee District #1 and Levee District #9



SBFCA Goals

- Achieve 200-yr protection for urban areas through the Feather River West Levee Project (FRWLP)
- Achieve 100-yr protection for remaining rural, southern portion of basin



SBFCA Approach

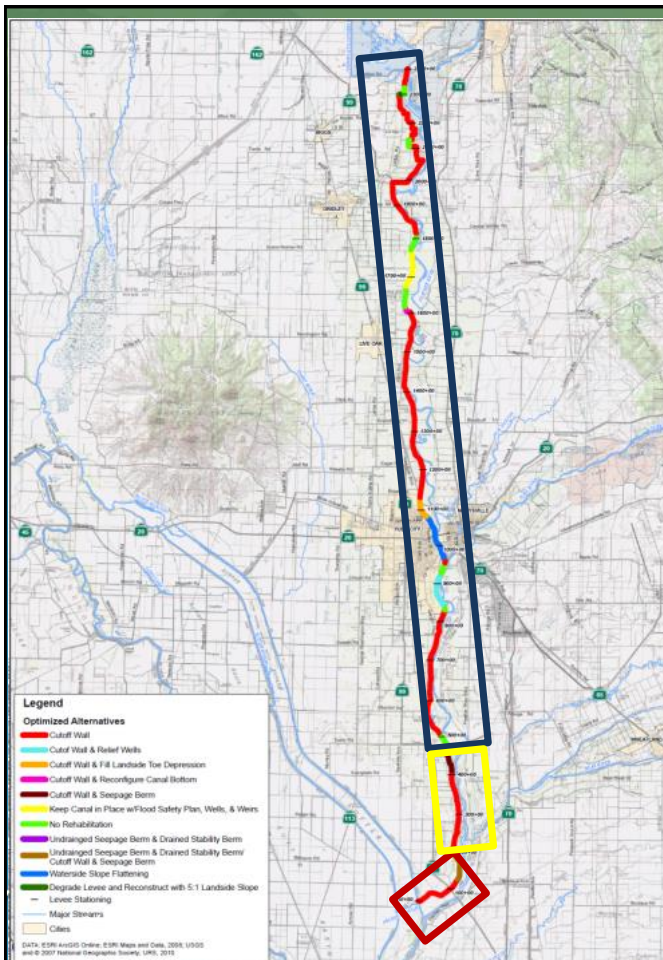
- SBFCA is lead agency for levee rehabilitation for the Sutter Basin
- Accomplish rehabilitation through parallel efforts:
 - Construction in advance of the Corps via DWR EIP/CVFPP
 - Collaboration with Corps Feasibility Study

Project Funding Status

- Local Funding (SBFCA) – Bond Issuance in May 2013
- State Funding (DWR) – Construction Funding Agreement in June 2013 (Commitment letter in May 2013)
- Federal Funding – no Federal funding required at this time (credit toward future federal project)
