**APPROVAL OF JUNE 4, 2014 MEETING MINUTES**

**UPDATE ON SBFCA ACTIVITIES**

As reported by Mike Inamine, Executive Director:

The discovery of 12 Native American sites, which includes 4 burial sites, has caused a work suspension at these sites. SBFCA is in negotiations with the Corps, Tribes, and the State Historic Preservation Office. This has a potential to cost up to \$10.8 million and may cause a delay in the completion of the levee project.

Funding risks to the Feather River West Levee Project (FRWLP) include the timing of receiving funding from the Urban Flood Risk Reduction grant, crediting of completed work and State Bond 1E funding availability.

The overall FRWLP project budget is \$279.8 million. The SBFCA Cost Share is about \$50 million.

#### APPOINTMENT TO SBFCA FINANCE COMMITTEE

Chair Sandi Frederickson appointed Steve Scriven as CADAC's representative for the SBFCA Finance Sub-Committee.

#### COMMUNITY OUTREACH ISSUES

Issues discussed were effects of levee construction on ground water tables; safety of trucks crossing railroad tracks; property negotiations; SBFCA Board member appointments to fill CADAC vacant positions.
