REGULAR MEETING

Chair Sandi Fredrickson called the meeting to order at 12:40 p.m. The Secretary Pro-tem called the Roll of the Committee and attendance is shown above.

APPROVAL OF JUNE 3, 2015 MEETING MINUTES

Minutes of the June 3, 2015 meeting will be filed as presented.

UPDATE ON SBFCA ACTIVITIES

Executive Director Mike Inamine reported that work has started in Butte County. There are 10.5 miles of levees with 9 miles of slurry walls to be constructed. 60% of the construction will be completed this year with 40% to be completed in 2016. It was originally scheduled to be finished this year but the delay from the Native American cultural issues will keep it from being completed this year. Work will begin on the permitting and design of the Oroville Wildlife Area

Flood Stage Reduction project. The percentage of SBFCA cost share will be 14% instead of 24% because of the dual purpose.

There are three gaps in Sutter County left to finish – at the 5<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge, Yuba City water intake and the Union Pacific Railroad. Work in Sutter County may not begin for a couple months due to the ongoing Native American cultural resources issue. Once work can be started on these gaps it should only take a couple weeks to finish. Construction on one mile of levee at Laurel Avenue will not begin until 2016
