E. GRIDLEY ROAD CLOSURE PLANNED FOR LEVEE WORK

WHAT: The East Gridley Road Bridge will be closed overnight for a three-week period in August for levee construction work on Feather River west levee. Daytime traffic controls will be in place to accommodate road construction operations.

WHEN: 6:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., August 1-20, 2016 (bridge closed)
Note: traffic controls in place at all other times



WHY: SBFCA initiated construction of the Feather River West Levee Project in 2013, a \$288 million flood improvement project to protect 95,000 people and \$7 billion in damageable property. The project includes 44 miles of levees from Thermalito Afterbay south to the confluence of the Feather River and Sutter Bypass. Construction of a slurry wall where the East Gridley Road Bridge crosses the levee is part of the remaining work to be done before the project is completed in November 2016.
