CALL TO ORDER

Chair Jon Munger called the meeting to order. The roll of the committee and attendance was called and is reflected above.

ACTION ITEM

Approval of April 10, 2017 Meeting Minutes:
Motion made by Sandy Watson to approve minutes as presented. Motion seconded by Dan Cucchi.
Motion was approved unanimously.

SBFCA STAFF REPORTS

Executive Director Mike Inamine detailed the status of the Board's Emergency Order and discussed the Agency's ongoing response to the winter and spring storm events. Critical repairs to the Feather River West levee in Yuba City (Gilsizer to Whitaker Hall) and a five-mile segment south of Star Bend are a high priority. Toward that end, the Agency is seeking state and federal funding to complete these projects in 2017.

Director of Engineering Michael Bessette provided an update of ongoing construction projects. Work on the completion projects will be done by the end of summer. The works includes the installation of a seepage berm at the Yuba City Raw Water Intake and relief wells at the Union Pacific Railroad crossing and just north of Star Bend. Work on the one-mile Laurel Avenue Repair project is underway, starting with the removal of the seepage berm installed during the spring storm events and followed by the

deconstruction of the levee. A slurry wall will be installed. The project is expected to be completed by the end of October.

In other work, DWR is completing erosion repair work north of Fifth Street Bridge, which is likely the result of rapid drawdown of the Feather River. The project involves the installation of 900 linear feet of rip rap and should be done by early June.
